ABOUT D.El.Ed. PROGRAMME

D.El.Ed. course is professional teacher training course for elementary teachers. It is a full-time diploma course of two years duration. After completing a long 2 years academic program, D.El.Ed. professionals become eligible to work at elementary level schools. D.El.Ed. provides exiting opportunities for learning and professional growth. This programme is committed to impart high quality education and to contribute in the process of national building.

PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES

- To imbibe teaching skill, develop pedagogic knowledge and understanding about the parameters responsible for learning.
- To acquire conceptual and analytical abilities required for effective decision making.
- To develop leadership qualities, team spirit, analytical abilities and entrepreneurship.
- To stimulate the thinking process and generate inquisitiveness.
- To develop soft skills and to ensure holistic personality development.

APPROVAL & AFFILIATION

This course is recognized by National Council of Teacher Education Act, 1993 by Northern Regional Committee under section 14(3) and affiliated to State Council of Educational Research and Training.

INTAKE & RESERVATION

There is a provision for reservation of seats for following categories:

- a) 85% seats are reserved for those candidates who have passed qualifying examination (12th pass) from school/study center located in National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi.
- b) 15% seats are reserved for candidates who have passed qualifying examination (12th pass) from school/study center outside NCT of Delhi will be states /UT, other than National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi.

ELIGIBLITY CRITERIA

Any Candidates who have qualified 10+2 or equivalent examination from any recognized board with a minimum of 50% marks are eligible to apply.

Five percent relaxation of marks in the qualifying examination is allowed for candidates belonging and applying under the categories of Scheduled Caste, or Scheduled Tribe or Person with Disability (PWD) only.

The maximum age should not be more than 24 years as on 30th September' 2019.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The admission to the course is completely merit-based. For calculating percentage of marks of 10+2 examination conducted by CBSE, best 5 subjects including at least one language will be considered. In case of boards other than CBSE, the percentage of marks shall be calculated as per passing criteria laid down by concerned board, keeping in view Eligibility Conditions mentioned in the prospectus.

For general and reserved categories, the SCERT conducts counselling for all the colleges affiliated with it for 90% seats except for management quota seats. Students are required to choose the college/institute during the phases of counseling. The Institute conducts admission for 10% management quota seats as per the guidelines by Government of NCT of Delhi.

EXAMINATION & EVALUATION

The programme is comprised of 10 papers in both years. Each paper is of 100 marks with the ratio of 75:25 for external and internal assessment. The external assessment is based on student's achievement in End-Term Examination conducted by SCERT and internal assessment is based on the student - teacher's performance in the practicum component. The projects / assignments in the practicum component is continuously assessed internally by the respective faculty members under the guidance and supervision of the principal of the institution.
