(Contributions of Indian scholars in astronomy, medicine, architecture, and mathematics)

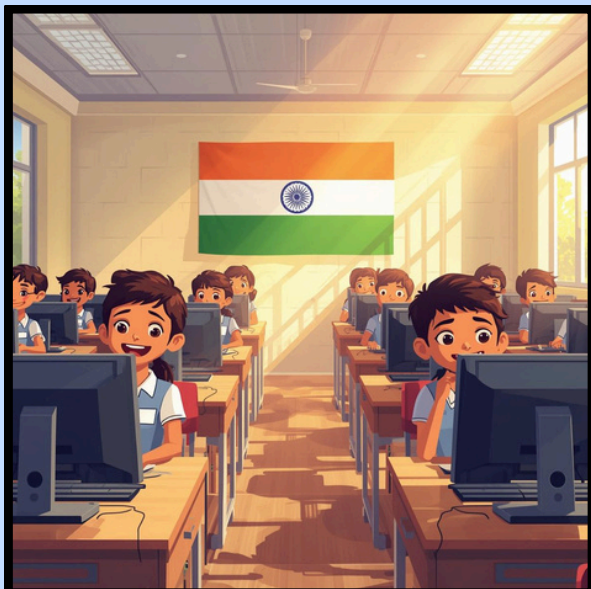

PAPER SUBMISSION

Guidelines for Paper Submission

- All submissions must be made in word format
- Abstracts should not exceed 400 words.
- The manuscript (in about 3000 words) should be sent only by e-mail in MS Word document (A4 Size, Single Column, 12 font Point, Times New Roman, Single line spacing).
- A separate covering page indicating the theme, sub-theme, title of the paper, Name of the author(s), Designation, Organizational address, Phone number, E- mail address should be sent with the manuscript.
- After sending a soft copy of your paper, you will receive acknowledgement via email.
- Referencing should be as per the latest APA style otherwise rejected.
- The selected papers may be published in our journal as per the guidance of the Editorial & Referee Board.
