30.08.2024

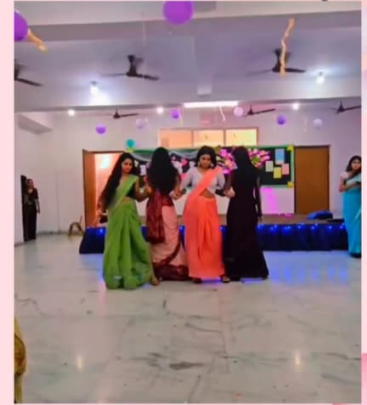

25.10.2024

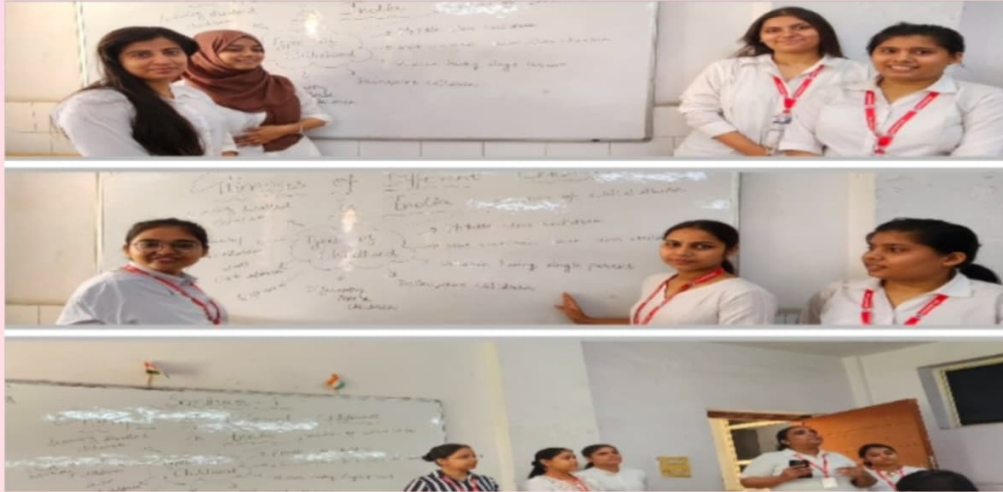
