
MUSKAN




ATHRA PRATHAP






During my first year in GIAST, I came to know various skills and techniques which helped me as a would-be teacher and as an Individual.

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


SHAMBHAVI KUMARI

In GIAST my experience was really great, I took part in all the activities related to all the subjects, events, and programs, which were really beneficial for me.




VANSHIKA KHARI

BHUMIKA SURI



The best thing that happened to me this year was to choose D.EL.ED, as the teacher who is very open and makes the environment comfortable for me, has been very helpful.





My strengths are:- | am confident, always curious about learning new things, punctual, honest, and helpful.




MANSI RAO

I also have some hobbies in which I like dancing, reading books, painting.





PRERNA VERMA



I will apply it in my teaching learning process like integration method with students everyday to make learning meaningful and better help in develop national value and respect for society.




RASHIKA SHARMA








SHIVANGI MITTAL




DISHA MINGLANI




SHEFALI ARORA
